


# **EDINBURGH AIRPORT – INFO SHEET 2020**

**1.** Two **exits** from luggage bay. <u>"Shop exit"</u> is close to everything. <u>"Café exit"</u> – buses will be first.



## 2. Buses to Princes Street, Edinburgh

- Airlink/Skylink 100 goes to the heart of Edinburgh, the straightest way possible.
- **Skylink 200** goes to Leith through Northern parts of Edinburgh. Stops in Newhaven.
- **Skylink 300** goes West and South, going through possible sleeping areas like Fountainbridge, Toll Cross, University area. Following Newington St. it is finishing at Cameron Toll.
- **Skylink 400** not to the city centre. This one is for southern Edinburgh

## <u>Estimated times</u> vary (traffic of course)

- Skylink 100 (every 10 min) 30-40min between Wavery Station Airport
- Skylink 200 (every 30 min) 50-60min between Ocean Terminal (Leith) Airport
- Skylink 300 (every 20 min) 60 80min between Cameron Toll Airport



**Ticket office** marked on the map in <u>blue</u>. You will see bus stops marked with letters.

## **Bus Prices:**

Return ticket: £7,50Single ticket: £4,50

**Night bus** – between 00:45AM and 4:15AM – there is a night bus N22 going every 30min. The fare is 3, and the bus goes from the Airport – City Centre – Leith Ocean Terminal.

**REMEMBER** – you can buy your ticket with the bus driver BUT you need to have the EXACT change to do so. No cards, no returns (if you have 10 pounds, you pay or you do not go. There is a possibility of a card payment but not guaranteed)

## 3. Tram to Princes Street, Edinburgh

They go every 10-15minutes. It takes 40 minutes to Princes Street

It goes through Haymarket Station, Princes Street, York Place

**Ticket machine** marked on the map in <u>black</u>.

#### **Tram Prices:**

Return ticket: £9Single ticket: £6,50

- **4.** Taxi around £20-25. In the grey parking building road level.
- **5. Rent a Car** (follow the tram rails)



# **EDINBURGH – MOVE AROUND RULES**

### 1. Bus tickets

- a) Where in travel-shops or with the bus driver
- Lothian Bus HQ 31 Waverley Bridge (bottom), next to the train station
- REMEMBER you can buy your ticket with the bus driver BUT you need to have the EXACT change to do so. (card payment exist but are not guaranteed)
- b) **Prices** (children between 5-15 pay half price):
- Day ticket £4,50 (you can use any bus you want until midnight, not 24h)
- Day family ticket £9 (as above, for 2 adults and up to 3 children between 5-15y)
- **Single** ticket £1,80 (1 journey with 1 bus)
- Week ticket £20+£3 (for making a Ridacard, only in HQ)

## 2. Useful bus transport apps:

- a) Transport for Edinburgh Mobile App made by Lothian Buses:
- Interactive map
- Bus routes
- b) Lothian buses m-tickets by Corethree Limited
- Possibility to buy tickets (registration required)
- 1 device is only for 1 passenger
- **3.** Tram Prices (for journeys not to the airport)
  - Single ticket £1,80
  - Return ticket £3,40
  - Day ticket £4,50

#### 4. IMPORTANT

- a) REMEMBER that in UK people drive on the left!!!
  - it goes for avoiding cars and finding the right bus stop
- b) Watch out for the uneven, slippery cobbles in the Old Town!
