

Dubai AIRPORT (DXB) – INFO 2020

- 1. 3 terminals linked with the airport shuttle. T1 and T3 are additionally linked by the red metro line
- 2. **RED METRO LINE –** direction UAE Exchange, along Sheikh Saeed Road
- **Popular stops** (regarding hotel areas):
 - Union (change for the Green Metro Line/Deira)
 - Burjuman (change for the Green Metro Line /Deira/hotels close to the old town)
 - Burj Khalifa/Dubai Mall (Downtown region)
 - o Mall of Emirates
 - o Dubai Internet City

- Price depends on the number of crossed zones

3. Busses


Because of the large number of connection, it is advised to use Wojhati – through the website of the RTA or mobile app

Price – flat rate for the airport 7,50 AED

- 4. Taxi flat rate for the airport 25 AED + 2 AED/kilometre
- 5. Rent a car offices are close to the exits from the baggage halls

1. NOL card and paper tickets

- a) Where to buy offices of the RTA look for the red sign
- b) Tickets machines can add-on money to your NOL or you buy a paper ticket there
- c) Children less than 5 years old and 90 cm of height travel free (concessions are only for residents of Dubai Blue NOL card)
- d) You use NOL with metro, buses and trams !!!

2. Useful info:

- Wojhati RTA webpage or mobile app help with choosing busses and moving around Dubai
- \circ $\;$ First 3 rows of seats in the bus are reserved solely for women
- First/last cart of metro are reserved for women with chilren and VIP passangers (Gold NOLs cost more)
- Public transport is air-conditioned, with WiFi and USB charging ports
- $\circ~$ Don't forget about taxis. Prices are reasonable: 12 AED upon getting in +

2AED/kilometre (prices go up in the evening and during holidays and events)
