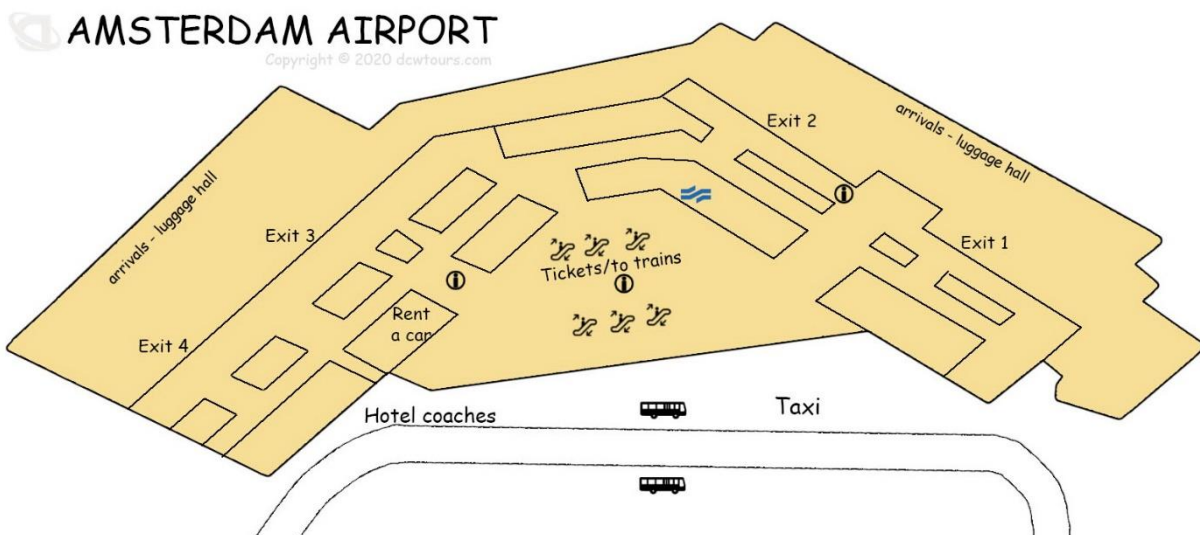




# AMSTERDAM Airport (AMS) – INFO 2020

## 1. **SPRINTER** – train line directly to Amsterdam Centraal or Zuid Stations

- **15-20 minutes** of travel time
  - 2 stops on the way to Centraal: Lelylaan and Sloterdijk stations
- Operational Times: **6.30 AM** till **00.30**
- **Price** for a single ticket: **5,50€** (to Centraal), **4€** (to Zuid)
- Where to buy? - yellow-blue machines at the arrivals hall or point 1 below



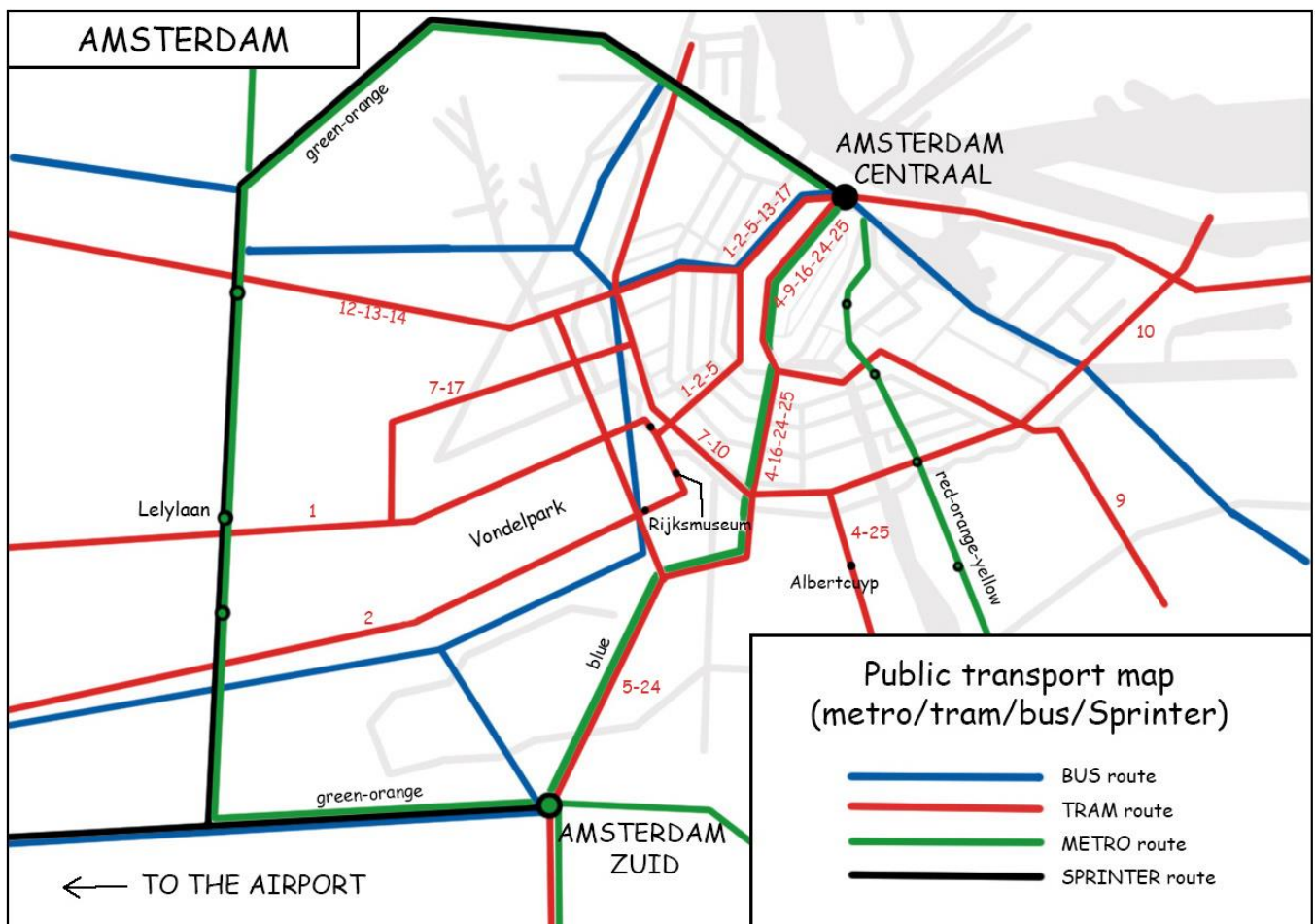
## 2. **Busses**

- **GVB** company bus number **69**
  - **Price** for a single ticket, duration 60 minutes is **3,20€**
  - Goes to Nieuw Sloten then you have to change for another one if you want to go further
- **Connexion** (Cxx) company busses numbers **195, 300, 341, 397**
  - **Price** for a single ticket (GVB+Cxx), duration 90 minutes is **6,50€**
  - **Return ticket 11,25€**





- 195 – goes to Lelylaan
  - 300 – goes to Amsterdam Zuidoost
  - 341 – goes to Amsterdam Zuid
  - 397 – goes to Amsterdam Zuid, Rijksmuseum, finishes close to Jordaan
- **Nightbus N97** – flat price **5,50€**.  
Goes to Elandsgracht (close to Rijksmuseum and Jordaan) between 1 AM and 5 AM
  - Where to buy? - yellow-blue machines at the arrivals hall or point 1 below
3. **Taxi** – to get to the main centre of the city is between **45 and 55€**
  4. **Rent a car** – offices are at the arrivals hall, right from the exit from the building (marked on the plan)





## AMSTERDAM – move around town

### 1. Amsterdam Travel Ticket – one ticket for GVB metro/tram/bus

- a) Where to buy? – at the airport in yellow-blue machines, kiosques, information centre – all in the main space of the arrival hall
- b) Within it there is a ticket from/to the airport using: train, GVB, Connexion 397 or N97!
- c) You must always scan the ticket upon entering and exiting the vehicle
- d) Time validity is for a day. A day starts at midnight and finishes at 4 AM the next day (meaning - 28 hours in total)
- e) **Price:**
  - 1 day – 17€
  - 2 day – 22,50€
  - 3 days – 28€

### 2. OV chip card disposable ticket – regular tickets

- a) Available mainly for GVB (Amsterdam Public transport) metro/tram/buses
- b) Work within a time limit – 60 minutes, 90 minutes, 24 hours etc
- c) **Prices:**
  - Single ticket (60 minutes, GVB)– 3,20€
  - Single (90 minutes, GVB with Connexion) – 6,50€
  - 24 hours (GVB only) – 8€
  - 48 hours (GVB only) – 13,50€
  - 72 hours (GVB only) - 19€
  - 96 hours (GVB only) – 24,50€
- d) Tickets for Connexion and other busses can be bought at their websites



### 3. Useful information

- a) Always scan your tickets upon entering and exiting a vehicle
  - b) You can buy ticket with the bus driver using a credit card only
  - c) Children 4-11 years old pay half fare. Under 4 years of age travel free
  - d) **I Amsterdam City Card** – multipack for tourists
- You get attractions and GVB unlimited travel within the city, bike rental and cruise options (check the article link)
  - **Prices:**
    - 24 hours - 65€
    - 48 hours – 85€
    - 72 hours – 105€
