

Prague Airport (PRG) – INFO 2021

1. AIRPORT EXPRESS – bus to Main Train Station

- 40 minutes of travel time
- Operational Times: **6.30 AM** till **10.00.** Goes every 30-60 minutes
- Where to buy tickets? Airport offices (Visitor Centre)
- Price 8€ (one-way)
- From Main Train Station possibility to change for Red metro C

2. Intercity Coach by RegioJet – bus to Florenc (Pod výtopnou 13/10)

- 40 minutes of travel time
- Operational Times: varies check online
- Where to buy tickets? Online (link in the article)
- Price 65 KCZ (one-way)
- From Florenc bus station possibility to change for Red metro C or yellow B

3. Busses

- You use the Integrated Tansport Card (one ticket for everything)
 - Where to buy? In airport offices, yellow automatic machines and with the bus driver
 - <u>Prices?</u> These are time-tickets (check below)

• Bus 119

- Goes to Veleslavin metro station (green A)
- Travel time 15 minutes
- Operational hours 4.20 AM − 9.40 PM (every 10 minutes)

• Bus 100

- Goes to Zličín metro station (yellow B)
- Travel time 20 minutes
- Operational hours 5.30 AM − 8.45 PM (every 15-30 minutes)

Nightbus 910

- Many bus stops the interesting ones close to Dancing House and Vysehrad
- Operational hours 9 PM 4 AM (every 15-30 minutes)





4. Taxi

- Stop in front of the terminal 1 and T2
- Prices (entrance 60 KCZ then per 1km)
 - FIX taxi 36 KCZ
 - Taxi Praha 28 KCZ
- Price to Old Town 400 to 500 KCZ
- 5. **Rent a car** check the offices in the adjacent building.





Prague – move around town

- 1. Integrated Ticket can use bus, metro, tram, funicular
 - a) Where to buy? at the airport/in the city in transport offices and information points; in yellow automatic machines and wit the bus driver
 - b) Prices:
 - 30 minutes 24 KCZ
 - 90 minutes 24 KCZ
 - 1 day 24 KCZ
 - 3 days 24 KCZ
 - c) Reductions for children 6-15 years old (younger travel free)
 - d) Remember to PUNCH it before you start using it.
 - e) Useful apps: PID Litacka (official), Praha timetable (Goder Hsu), IDOS (Mafra)
 - f) Times:
 - metro 4.45 AM to midnight (no night connections)
 - trams all day, between midnight and 5 AM every 30 minutes
 - busses all day, between midnight and 5 AM less frequent

2. Metro

a) 3 lines
