



BARCELONA Airport (BCN) – INFO 2021

1. **Aerobus** – direct connection (both terminals)
 - To stops: Pl. Catalunya, Sepúlveda-Urgell, Pl. Espanya, Gran Vía-Urgell and Pl. Universitat
 - Single ticket is 5,90 €
 - Round trip ticket – 10,20 € (valid 2 weeks)
 - Where to buy tickets? Online and in automatic machines at the bus stop
 - Travel time – 35 minutes (goes every 5-10 minutes)
 - Working hours 5:30 AM to 1:05 AM

2. **Trains** (both terminals)
 - **Metro L9 South**
 - You will have to interchange to other lines
 - Accessible with T-dia (only) and Hola Barcelona (read below)
 - Single ticket price – 5,15 €
 - Where to buy? Red-grey machines with TMB logo
 - Travel time around 30 minutes
 - Works between 5AM and midnight (Friday and Saturday – all night)
 - **RENFE R2 (Nord line)**
 - You will have to interchange to other lines
 - Accessible with T-dia (only) and Hola Barcelona (read below)
 - Single ticket price – 5,15 €
 - Where to buy? Red-grey machines with TMB logo
 - Travel time – varies, often running late
 - Goes every 30min from 5:42 AM to 11:38 PM

3. **Busses** (both terminals)
 - The only direct connection to city centre (Pl.Espanya) is number L46
 - Single ticket – 2,40 €
 - Accessible with T-tickets and Hola Barcelona (below)
 - The NIGHT busses are also direct (Pl.Catalunya) – N16, N17, N18
 - Single ticket – 2,40 €
 - Timetable changes
 - Accessible with T-tickets and Hola Barcelona (below)
 - There are various bus connections to other places – check our online article

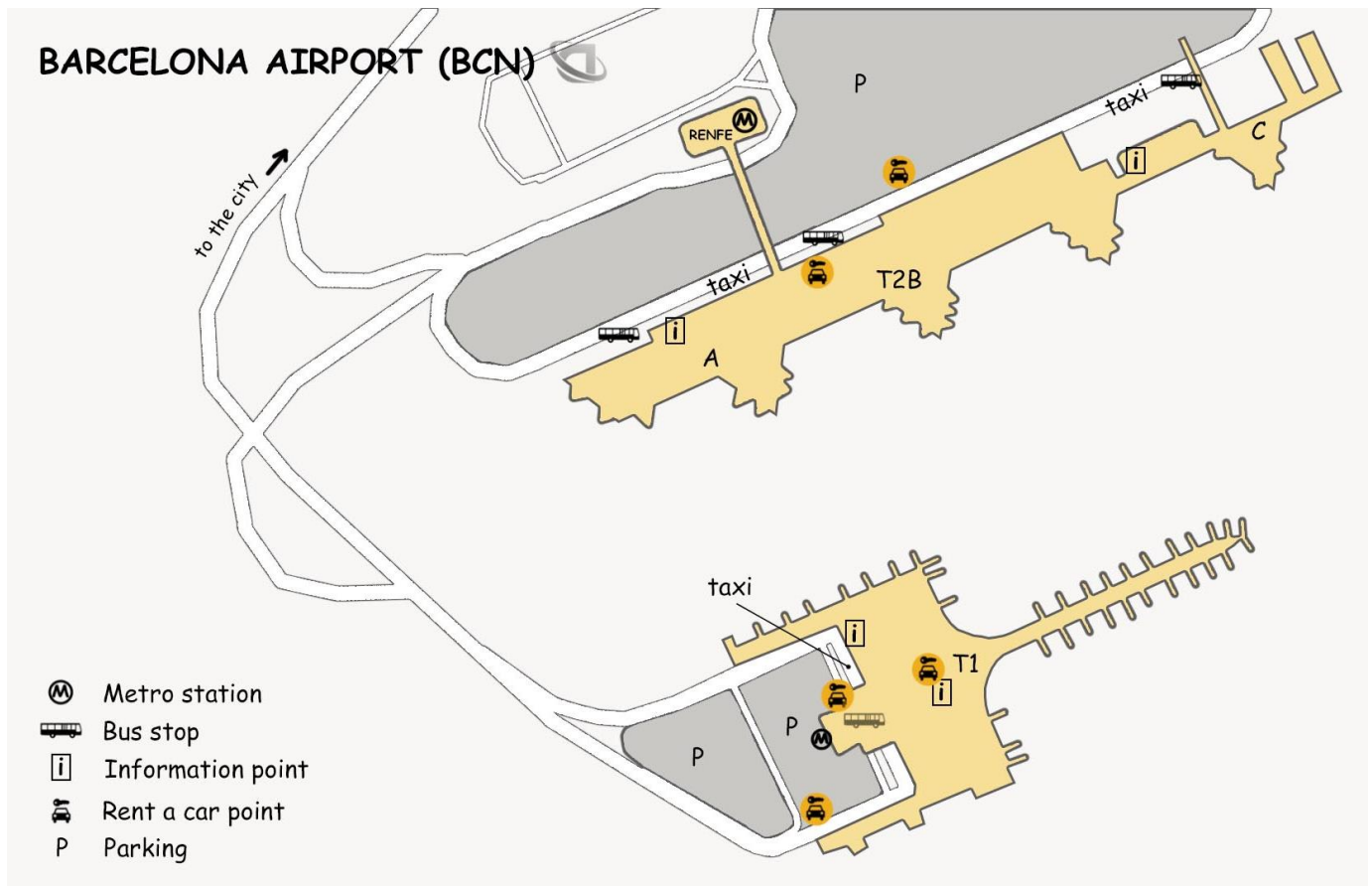
4. **Taxi** (both terminals)
 - Yellow-black (only one company. NO UBER!)





- **Prices**
 - Flat rate to the port – 39 €
 - Starting rate 4,30 € then 1,18-1,41 €/km (depends on the day of the week)
- Travel time to the center of the city takes 30-40 minutes

5. Rent a car – marked on the ma



BARCELONA – move around town

1. **Hola Barcelona travel card** – one card for public transport and the
 - a) Where to buy? – at the airport/in the city red-grey machines, online and TMB offices
 - b) Price:
 - 2 days (48h) - 16.30 €
 - 3 days (72h) - 23.70 €
 - 4 days (96h) - 30.80 €
 - 5 days (120h) - 38.00 €
 - c) Clock starts with the first validation
 - d) Airport connection - YES
 - e) **Covers metro, busses, trams, urban trains in zone 1 (FBC and RENFE) and funicular to Monjüic**





2. T-tickets

- a) Where to buy? – at the airport/in the city red-grey machines, online and TMB offices
- b) Official tickets of TMB (transport of Barcelona)
- c) Covers metro, busses, urban trains in zone 1 (FBC and RENFE) and funicular to Montjuïc
- d) With the exception of T-dia – they DO NOT include airport
- e) Price:
 - Single ride (1 zone) – 2,40 €
 - Single ride (5 zones, eg. To Blanes) – 7,35 €
 - T-Casual (1 zone only) – 11,35 €
 - T-Familiar – 10 €
 - T-dia (1 zone) – 10,50 €
- f) One journey is a duration of 75 minutes when you can interchange



3. Metro

- a) 12 lines in the city and around
- b) TMB, FGC and RENFE – these are the train companies. You can use all of it only in zone 1
- c) Work between **5 AM and midnight** (Friday and Saturday night – all night)
- d) Watch out for thieves
- e) Map of the lines accessible online through the article

4. Busses

- a) Around 100 lines
- b) Work day and night

5. Funicular to Montjuïc

- a) Links the metro station Parallel and Av. Miramar (in the middle of the hill)
- b) Then you buy a separate ticket for Teleferico de Montjuïc
- c) Teleferico de Montjuïc (from Av. Miramar to the Castle) is not the same as the Aeri del Port (red cable cars over the port, also to the Castle)

6. Taxi

- a) Yellow-black (only one company. NO UBER!)
- b) **Prices**
 - Starting rate 2,25 €
 - then 1,18-1,41 €/km (depends on the day of the week)

7. Trams cover Besòs and Llobregat regions – you probably won't use them

8. Rent a bike/scooter – quite popular. The longer the cheaper and watch out for the safety instructions they will give you at the shop
