

PARIS – move around town

- 1. Due to the extensiveness of the city's public transportation network, <u>all the maps are</u> accessible through online links
- 2. Multiday ticket for transportation Paris Visite
 - a) Where to buy? at the counters of metro and train stations or in the automatic machines there
 - b) Ticket for ALL types of public transport MTR/RER, bus, tram
 - c) Time validity is for a 2-5 days. A day starts at 5:30AM and lasts for 24h.
 - d) Prices:

- 3. Multiday ticket transport+attractions Paris PassLib' or Paris Pass
 - a) Unlimited travel within zone 1-3 (de Gaulle airport not included!)
 - b) Free to visit attractions and monuments with a fast-track (skip the line option). List included with tickets.
 - c) Where to buy? Online, tourist offices, agents
 - d) Prices:

4. T+ tickets and Mobilis

- a) Where to buy? at the counters of metro and train stations or in the automatic machines there
- b) ALL types of public transport MTR/RER, bus, tram
- c) Children 4-11 years old pay half fare. Under 4 years of age travel free
- d) <u>Ticket T+ is valid for a single journey of 2 hours. Mobilis is valid for a day from</u> midnight to midnight
- e) In MTR/RER interchanging is possible, but not in the busses nor trams
- f) <u>Prices:</u>
 - Ticket T+ 1,90€
 - A bundle of 10 tickets T+ 25% reduction in price
 - Mobilis for 2 zones 7,50€
 - Mobilis for 3 zones 10€
 - Mobilis for 4 zones 12,40€
 - Mobilis for 5 zones 17,80€

5. Useful information

- a) Always show your multiday cards to the driver and/or scan it before entering
- b) When entering the MTR, the black line on one side of your ticket should be facing the floor. Ticket will be "eaten" and given back in a second place at the top of the machine
- c) Do not throw out your ticket until you are sure you will not interchange between the trains! Especially when interchanging between RER and MTR you need to cross the gates twice – each time using the ticket
- d) On the busses you can buy single tickets with the bus drivers
- e) Metro is colour and number coded it is one of the most helpful information there
- f) Watch out for automatic exterior doors at the stations and pick pocketers
- g) Rent a bike possible through Velib website
 - Prices: 1 day 5€, 7 days 15€, Without pass 1€/30min
